Hula Hoop Biodiversity

Basic Description: This activity is designed to let students use all their senses to determine the biodiversity in a variety of different areas of the site.

Throw the hula hoop in a short toss like a Frisbee, or alternately, walk over to a spot with tall plants and drop it from overhead.

Draw what you see:

- Record everything you can about their site- including drawing a picture of all the different plants you see in your hula hoop, in a circle on your page.
- Other factors to note and record are:
 - Sunny or shady?
 - Cold or warm?
 - Short plants or tall plants?
 - How many are flowering?
 - Any other visitors? i.e.: bugs, evidence of other animal visitors
