STREAM RESTORATION DETAILS

- 13.23 acres of wetland creation and enhancement.
- 790 linear feet of stream daylighting and culvert removal.
- 1,343 linear feet of boardwalk to protect natural resource areas and allow floodplain connection.
- 6.255 linear feet of stream restoration.
- 1,352 lbs/year of prevented total suspended solids to Broad Creek, which is one of the most impaired tributaries to the South River according to Arundel Rivers Federation.
- Broad Creek drainage area is 0.93 square miles with 9% Impervious Cover
- Eradication of existing invasive plant species on the site.
- Over 20 different species of pollinator plants included in the planting plan.

GOLF COURSE DETAILS

- Less chemical inputs due to new grass varieties
- Less fuel and labor maintaining sand bunkers
- Less watering due to Latitude Bermuda fairways and tees
- Targeted watering with a state-of-the-art irrigation system
- The Preserve at Eisenhower Golf Course has enjoyed the longstanding designation as a "Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary" by Audubon International. For more than a decade, it has maintained sound practices in six key areas: environmental planning, wildlife and habitat management, outreach and education, chemical use reduction, water conservation and water quality management.
